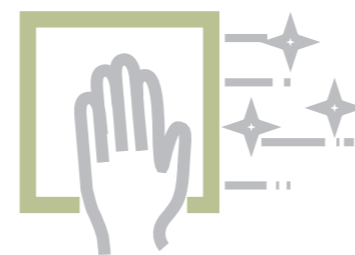
Partnerships
